Seller : How many rulers?

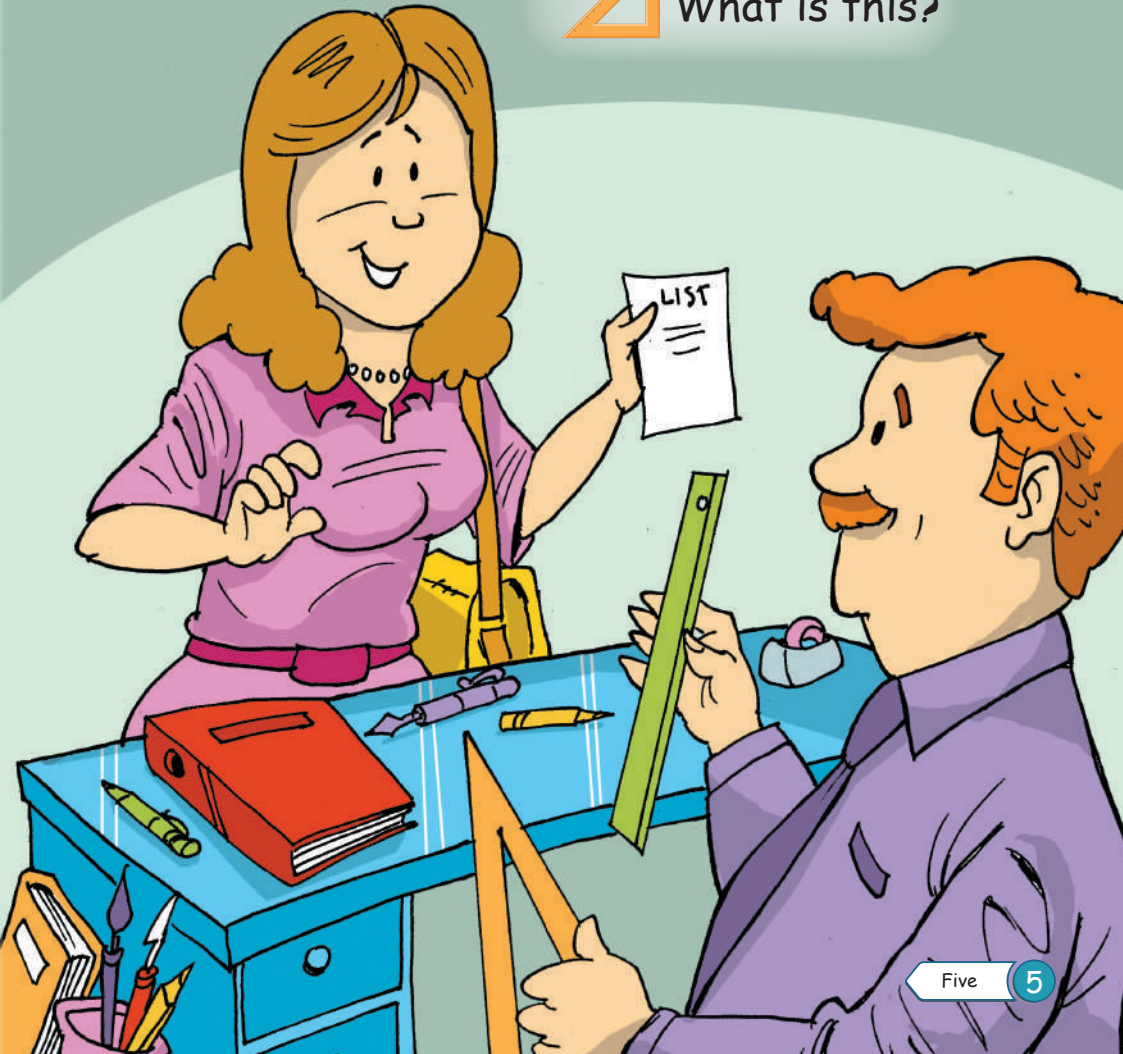
Mary : Two rulers.

Max : Give me five pencils, please. I want six notebooks, too.

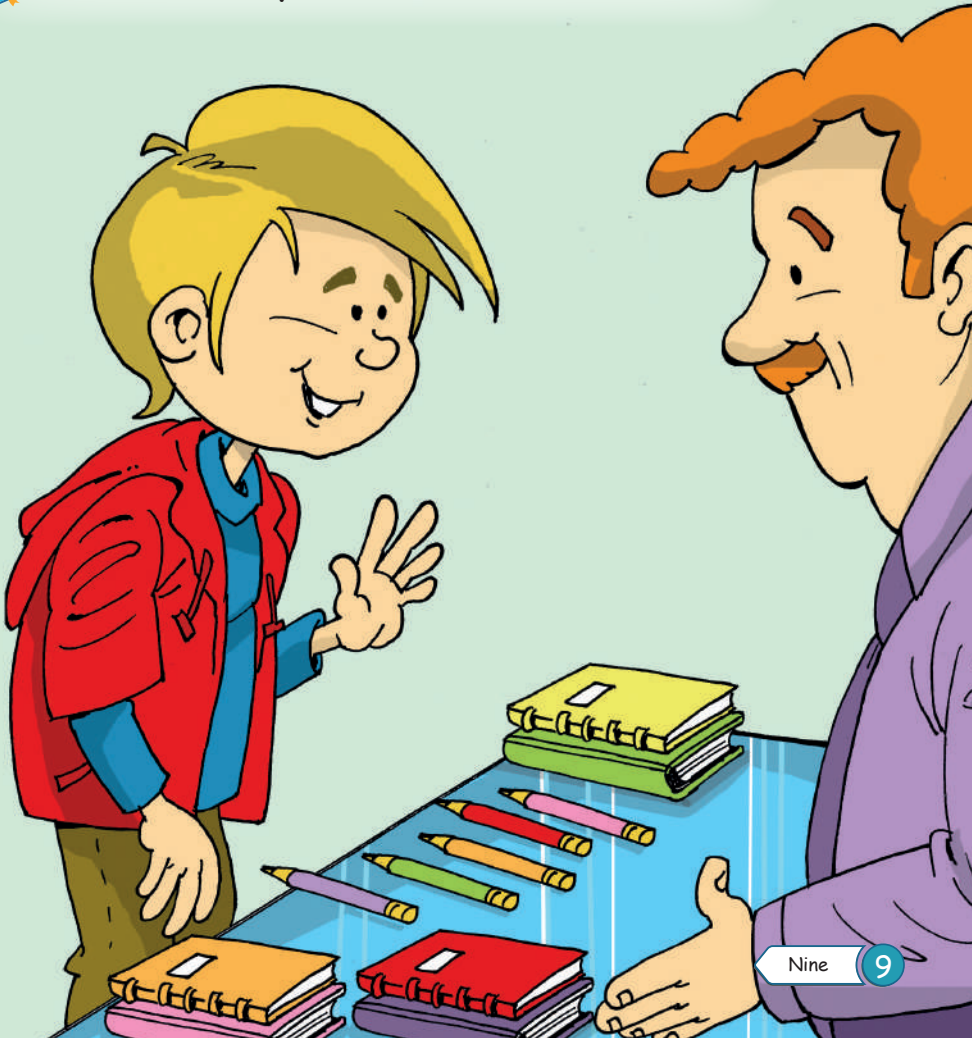
Seller : Here you are. What else?

Seller : You're welcome.



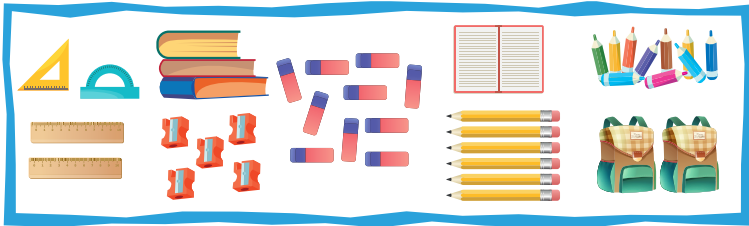
