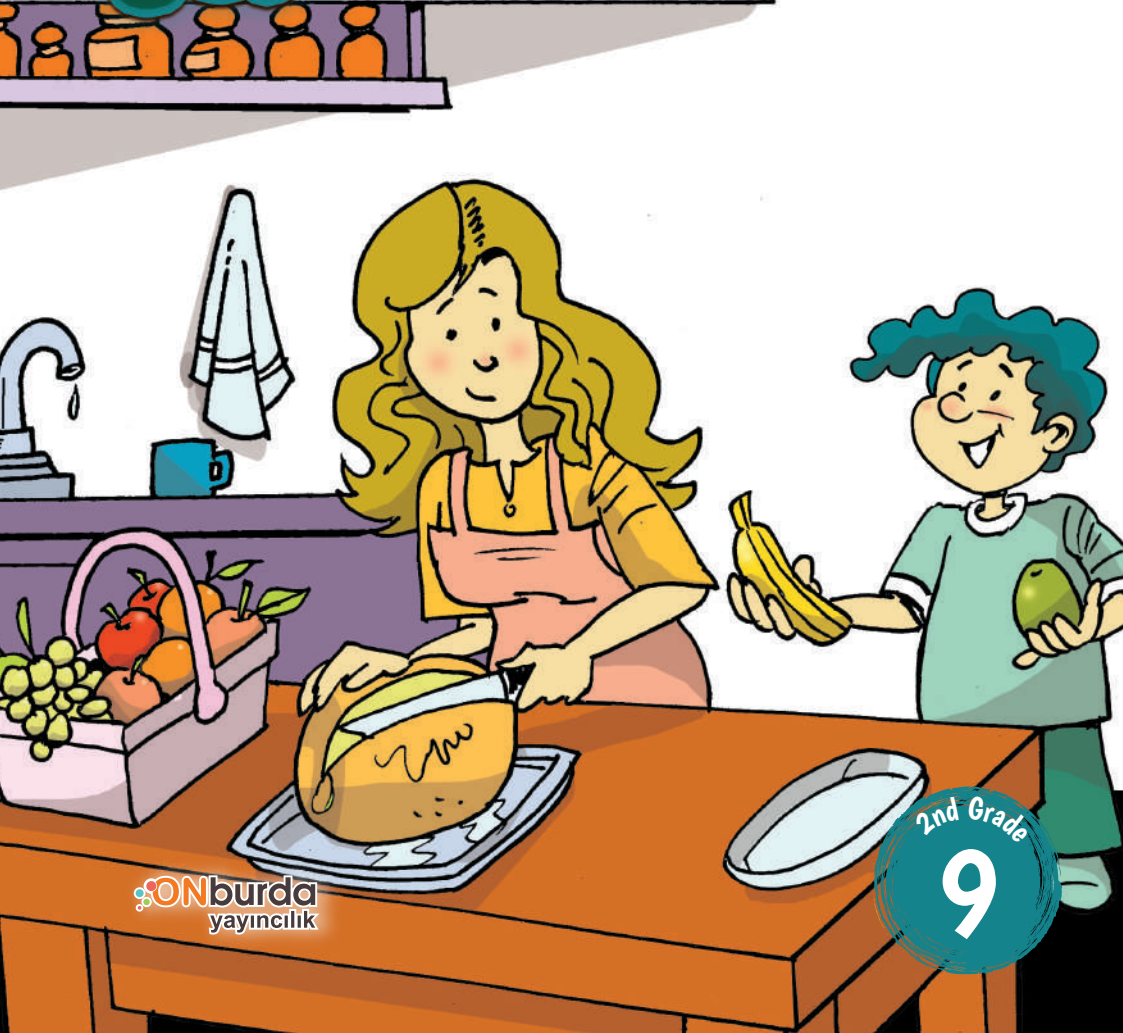

Liz : You're right. What colour are the apples?

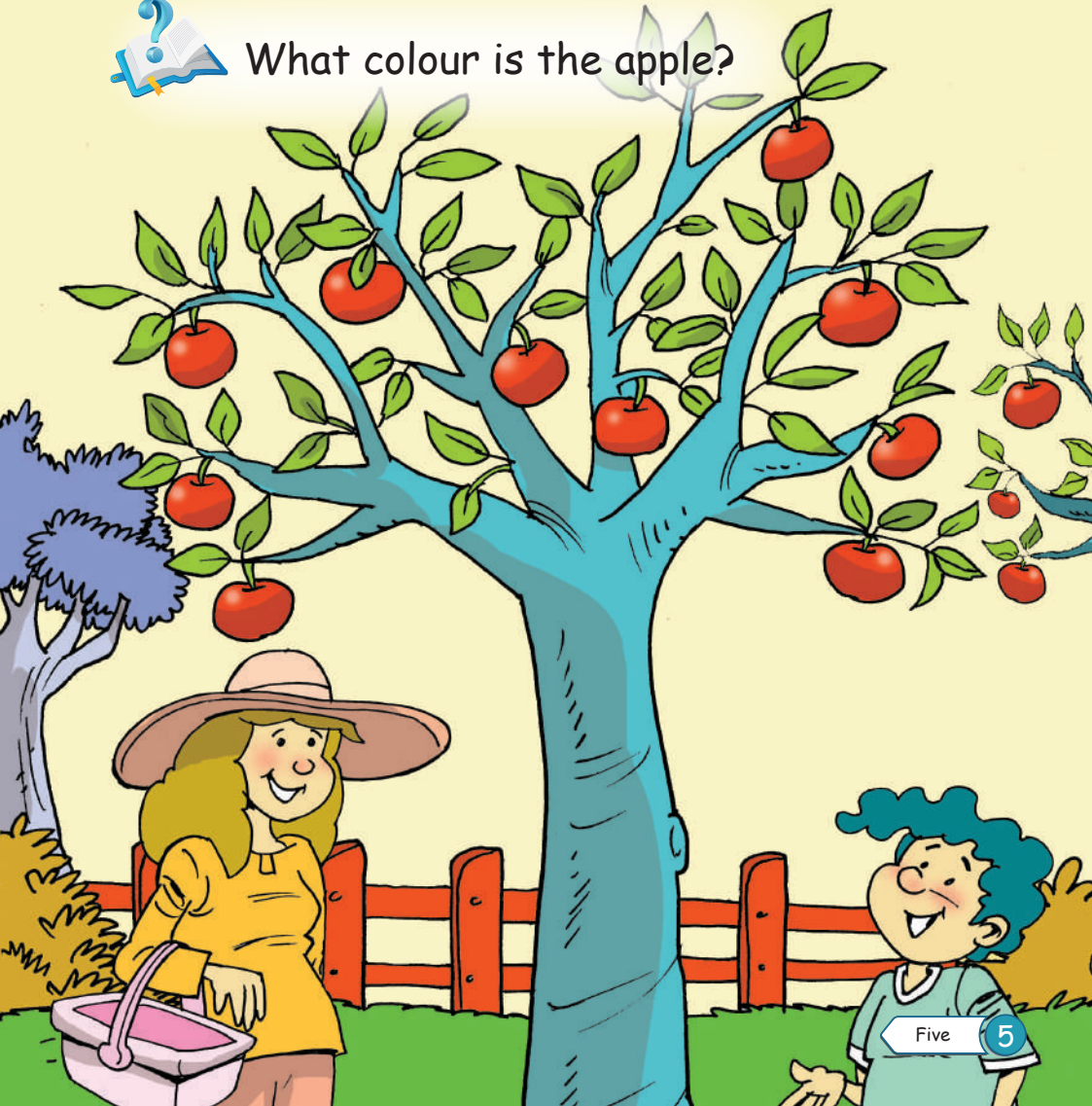
Boone : They are red.

Boone : Really?

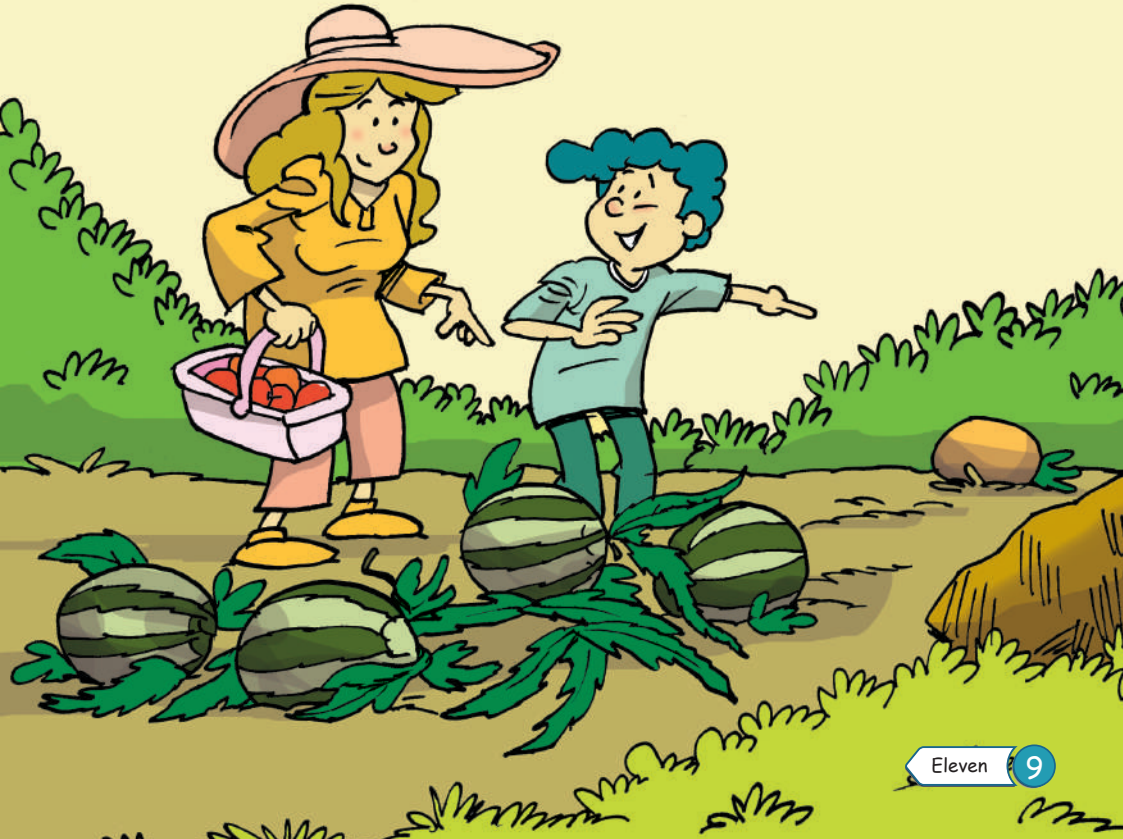
Liz : Of course. There are melons over there. A watermelon is green.

Boone : OK, mum. Cut the melon, please. I love melons.

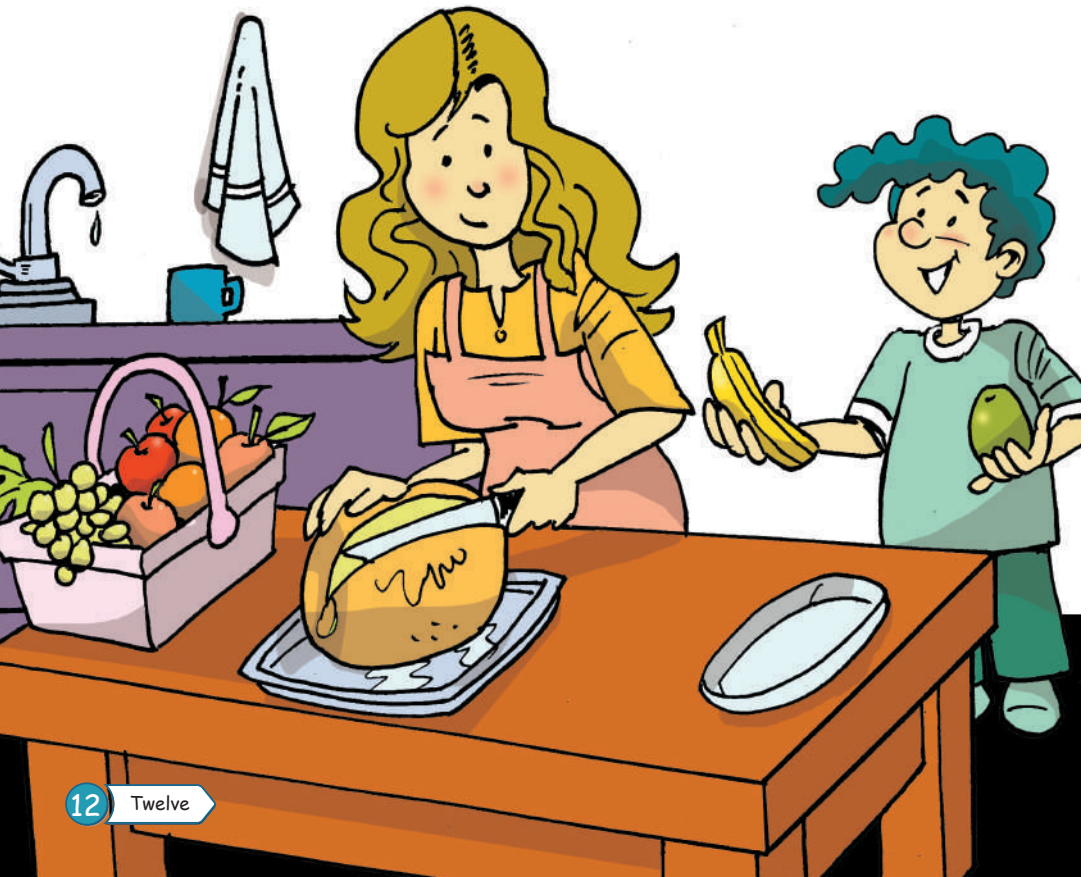
Liz : Do you like oranges?

Boone : Do you like fruit salad, dad?

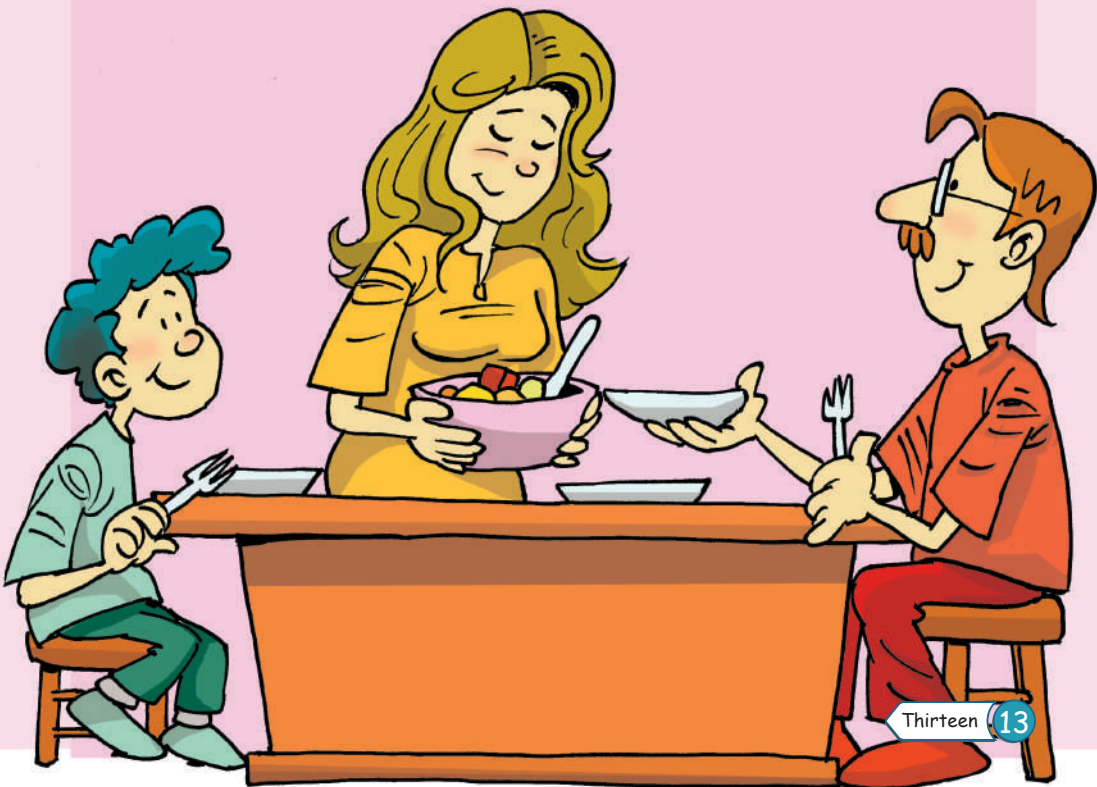
Jack : Yes, of course.


